Maintenance Cleaning

The tiles do not need waxing or protection with any product, as glazed tiles do not absorb dirt and have a completely sealed surface. Regular basic cleaning of the tiles can be performed as needed using water and a general-purpose cleaning agent, such as Fila Cleaner, according to the instructions. If machine cleaning is necessary, use a white polishing and cleaning pad. Abrasive pads are not allowed.

Stain Removal

Grease and soap residues can be removed with an alkaline cleaning agent, such as Fila PS87, according to the instructions.

BATHROOM FLOOR TILES

Maintenance Cleaning

Porcelain tiles are highly compact and do not absorb dirt. The tiles should not be treated with oils or wax. Regular basic cleaning of porcelain tiles can be performed as needed using water and a general-purpose cleaning agent, such as Fila Cleaner, according to the instructions. If machine cleaning is necessary, use a white polishing and cleaning pad. Abrasive pads are not allowed.

Stain Removal

Grease and soap residues can be removed with an alkaline cleaning agent, such as Fila PS87, according to the instructions.

Grout Joints

Clean the grout joints regularly to prevent dirt from accumulating. Keep the bathroom dry after cleaning by wiping the floors and grout joints with a squeegee. To clean discoloration on the grout, you can use a paste made from baking soda and water. Apply the paste to the grout with a soft brush and rinse it off. You can also clean the grout with a mild cleaning agent.

VINYL PLANK FLOORING IN THE APARTMENT

- As with all flooring, heavy furniture and appliances must be moved carefully. Protect the floor when moving heavy items.
- Furniture must have protectors suitable for PVC vinyl. If furniture is regularly moved, it should not be dragged across the floor surface.
- Non-staining, rubber-free protective or workstation mats must be used under wheeled office chairs, and wheeled furniture or carts must have wide, flat wheels.
- Door mats must be placed at entrances.
- Regularly clean dirt/sand from the floor by wiping or vacuuming. Do not use a rotating brush vacuum.
- The floor should be regularly cleaned with a pH-neutral cleaning agent.
