

## MAINTENANCE OF THE LIGHTED MIRROR CABINET

The lighted mirror cabinet is made of powder-coated steel, so cleaning with mild detergents is sufficient.

Do not use abrasive powders, scouring liquids, or solvent-based cleaners, as they may damage the painted surface. Test the suitability of the cleaning agent on a small, inconspicuous area first. Mirror surfaces can be cleaned with standard glass cleaners.

Regularly check the tightness of the hinge screws and tighten them if necessary.

## **REPLACING A LED TUBE**

You can replace a faulty LED tube yourself without any tools:

- 1. Before installation, ensure that the power to the fixture is turned off and that the installation area is clear of obstacles.
- 2. To remove the light cover, gently press the lower edge of the plastic cover upwards with your thumb.
- 3. Make sure the illuminating plastic surface of the LED tube points in the desired direction after installation.
- 4. Verify that the LED tube is compatible with the fixture in question.
- 5. Turn on the power and check that the LED tube functions properly.
- 6. Recycle the used tube as WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) at a designated E-Waste recycling point.
